Like this, we began to take out furniture, and scrape walls without a single drawing. Each day the idea of the store transforms, and with our architects' infatuation of following the moods of settings, designing in space, we begin to propose possible solutions.

A continuous floor of mixed materials, woods in different directions and ceramics with the corporate colours. The logo is captured within the floor at a grand scale. Subtle metal structures could support future shelves and drawers, hangers and fitting rooms. Some waves had to guide the products and the clients through the walls of the shop.
